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Dear Parent/Guardian,

We have completed our first month back to school and I would like to express gratitude to all in our school community for their efforts. As you will be aware, our school had significant work completed over the summer months with the installation of new windows and doors to the highest standard. We have also converted our bus shelter to a music room and we have had the outside of the school painted. Unfortunately, due to a supply issue or astro-turf is not yet ready but we expect this to be completed in the coming weeks.

Homework Policy:

Our school is constantly reviewing our homework policy in line with the latest research and we have made a conscious effort to scale back homework to focus on the essential tasks. Current policy is as follows:

Every night: Reading, Tables (Irish verbs for older classes)

Monday and Wednesday: Handwriting exercises to be done to best of child's ability

Thursday: Revision or completion of unfinished tasks.

Speech & Language Class

Welcome to Jessica Lyons SLT who is working with the children in the Speech & Language Class this year. This Friday, the 14th October, we will mark DLD awareness day. Developmental Language Disorder is the most prevalent childhood disability with an average of 2-3 students presenting with DLD in every Irish classroom. Thanks to all the children who have helped decorate our DLD awareness notice board with their lovely colouring.

Fiftieth Year Celebrations:

On February 1st 2023, our school will celebrate fifty years in existence. To commemorate this work has commenced on a number of initiatives including a calendar for Christmas and a show next February. Lunches:

Fresh Today provide hot school lunches and we encourage you to discuss menu options with your child. All children may bring a water bottle and filtered water is available in the school. Bottles should be washed out at home on a regular basis. If your child forgets a drink bottle, please do not drop bottles to the school as we do not wish to have bottles handled by multiple persons. We will arrange for a plastic cup for that day.

School Fees:

Our school fully understands that the "Back to School" period is an expensive time for families. We make an effort to reduce costs and it is important to note that the costs in our school are significantly lower than on average. For families with a number of children a payment plan can be discussed with Mr Martin.

Art, Crafts, Photocopying & Printing is an important compulsory charge for all pupils and is due now.

School Fund - each family is asked to contribute €20 four times per year or €80. While this is a voluntary charge, our school cannot meet its costs without this important contribution.

<u>Coats</u>: Please ensure that all clothing (coats/jumpers) are clearly labelled with your child's name.

Collection:

A reminder that children should not be collected during the school day unless they have an important appointment. The secretary's office is closed for lunch from 1.30pm-2pm and it will not be possible for children to be collected at this time.
